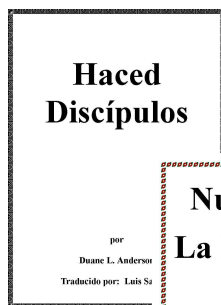

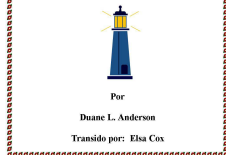

- Ministry Trip - Summer 2012

We will be spending some time this summer on the road visiting prayer partners, attending conferences, speaking in churches, and completing some technology projects. We will be traveling between our home/office here in Lynden throughout Southern California, on to Colorado Springs, Colorado for a Missions Technology conference (ICCM) and then back home in late July.

In addition to doing some work at the main office, visiting staff and making new contacts, we want to be available to provide updates to existing

AIBI friends and partners as opportunities arise. Our tentative route is in blue on the map above. If you are within a few miles of that route, or would like us to stop by for a brief visit and see if we can make your location into that route, we would love to see you. Our tentative schedule is as follows: June 16 — June 17: Southern Washington; June 21 — July 10: Los Angeles, California area; July 15 — July 20: Colorado Springs, Colorado. Please let us know if you would like to get together.

While we are in California, we will be working on one major project that we would appreciate your prayers and if you are in the area would love a hand on! This past month David was able to fly down for a business meeting at the AIBI Office in Norwalk which is at Sheri's parents residence and noticed that they had some additional roofing shingles blown off from recent storms down there. The house roof is over 20 years old and is wearing significantly. Our goal is to begin the process of stripping off the old roof the day that we arrive in order to get ready for the required first inspection and then re-roof as soon as possible so we can call for final inspection before other projects need to get started.

After a couple of weeks in California meeting with other AIBI staff, working on the computers at the AIBI Office, various projects and meeting with individuals and churches, we will be traveling over to the Phoenix, Arizona area for a brief visit with one of our staff, Bevan Lewis. Bevan and his wife Gerri have served on the Gila River Reservation since 1989. Following our stopover in Phoenix, we'll begin the trek up toward Colorado Springs for the International Conference on Computing and Mission (ICCM—<http://www.iccm.org>) in July. This will be a great time of renewing acquaintances, learning new technologies, learning how to more effectively address various technology issues and the list goes on. This year will be the first time that our family has been able to attend this conference AS A FAMILY. We would appreciate your prayers for this privilege as well, that the Lord would show each of us, including the kids how we can be more effective servants for Him.
